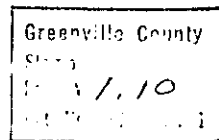
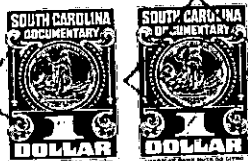

about one mile West of Blue Ridge High School, lying on the North and
