Provided, further, should the Optionee pay to the Optionor the sum of Nine Thousand and No/100 (\$9,000.00) Dollars on or before thirty (30) days from date hereof, the Optionor will extend to the Optionee an additional option to purchase the said property on or before January 1, 1973, for the price hereinabove mentioned (\$127,165.00) less any and all option monies paid. The Optionee shall, however, in the event the option is exercised, pay interest on the unpaid balance of the purchase price at the rate of six (6%) per cent, commencing April 8, 1972.

Provided, further, that upon payment of Twenty-Five Thousand and No/100 (\$25,000.00) Dollars to the Optionor by the Optionee, on or before January 1, 1973, plus accrued interest on the balance (being the original sales price less any option monies paid) at six (6%) per cent, the Optionor will further extend to the Optionee the option to purchase said property to January 1, 1974, all option monies paid to be applied to the (Continued on next page)
