8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12-12.2 Supplemental Code 1962) To carry on the primary purpose of construction, aluminum garages, residential housing including design, renovations, enlarging, repairing, erecting, completing, removing and otherwise engaging in such construction; also workshops, plants, factories, schools or other buildings or structures of every kind; engaging in earthwork of all kinds; dealing with any and all materials, articles or things incidental to or required for or useful in connection with any of aforesaid activities; buying, selling, distributing any and all materials, parts, components and products incidental to or required for or useful in any of aforesaid activities; employing engineers, architects, builders or contractors for any and all purposes aforesaid; making, executing and dealing with any contracts or assignments of contracts concerned with or related to any such activities; carrying on any other business which can be done advantageously in conjunction with and incidental to the activities aforesaid; and to do any and all other things necessary and proper to effect such purposes.

To engage in real estate and mortgage loan operations; to purchase, improve, develop, lease, exchange, dispose of and turn to account, real estate; to finance the purchase, improvement, development and construction of property and buildings belonging to this firm, or any other firm, person or corporation.

To mortgage, sell, lease, hypothecate or otherwise dispose of any lands, buildings or other structures, or any interest in such at any time owned or held by this Corporation under any character of ownership.

To negotiate loans on real estate, leasehold interests and other ownerships, real or personal; to lend money on bonds, notes or indentures secured by mortgages, trust deeds or other liens, on real estate, leaseholds or other ownerships, and real estate contracts; and to buy, sell, pledge, mortgage or otherwise deal in any such securities.

To borrow money and to execute mortgages and deeds of trust upon real or personal property as security therefor; and to execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, debentures or other negotiable or transferrable instruments.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed liberally both as to objects and powers; and it is expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific objects and powers shall not be held to restrict in any manner the general objects and powers of this Corporation; and in general to carry on any other business in connection or related thereto or incidental to the foregoing
