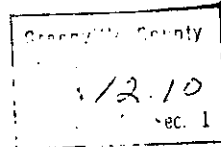
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Alan T. Calhoun,

in consideration of Eleven Thousand and No/100 (\$11,000.00) - - - - - Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto William T. Reed and Willa F. Reed, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain lot or parcel of land containing 9.6 acres, more or less, and being situate on Bird Mountain Ridge approximately three miles south of Tryon, North Carolina, in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more specifically shown and described as Lot No. 5 on a plat of a survey for Alan T. Calhoun by W. N. Willis, Engineers, dated April 6, 1972, to be recorded herewith, as beginning at an iron pin at the southwestern corner of the within described property and running thence N 2-45 E 549 feet to an iron pin at the branch; thence, following the branch as the line, the following chord line courses and distances, N 57 E 173 feet to a point, S 78-30 E 97 feet to a point, N 51-45 E 148 feet to a point, N 89 E 132 feet to a point, and N 43-50 E 81 feet to an old iron pin; thence S 2-45 W 1000 feet to an iron pin; thence N 80-00 W 150 feet to an old pine XXX; thence N 61-00 W 435 feet to the beginning corner. This is a part of the property devised to Alan T.
