The name of that corporation was changed from the North Greenville High School to North Greenville Baptist Academy by amendment to the Charter granted by the Secretary of State of South Carolina, on September 15, 1915. Under a special act of the Legislature enacted on April 21, 1951, North Greenville Baptist Academy became known as North Greenville Junior College. Under the terms of Act No. 428 of the 1951 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the State of South Carolina, North Greenville Junior College, a corporation, is conferred the right to acquire, hold and dispose of all kinds of property, both real and personal and to lease and mortgage the same, subject to the management of the affairs of said corporation by its duly elected Trustees. The undersigned Trustees are the successors to the Trustees named and designated in the above described deeds to the above described properties into North Greenville Junior College under that name and other names by which said corporation has been designated. North Greenville Junior College is the beneficial or equitable owner of all of the above described properties which are being used for the purposes of said institution in accordance with its charter and by-laws, and the purpose of this deed is to vest legal title in North Greenville Junior College, a corporation.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances in and to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforementioned unto North Greenville Junior College, its successors and assigns forever. And, the Grantors do hereby bind themselves, their successors and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto North Greenville Junior College, its successors and assigns, against the Grantors and their successors and assigns.
