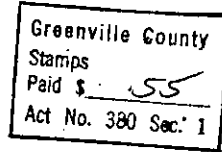
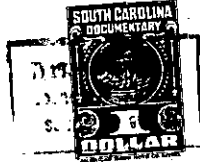

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Margaret J. Tucker, her heirs and assigns
forever:

ALL my right, title, interest in and to:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being
on the Eastern side of Allen Street, near the City of Greenville, County
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as
Lot No. 45 as shown on a plat entitled "Subdivision for Dunearn Mills",
dated August, 1948, prepared by Pickell & Pickell, and recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book S at
Page 175 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Allen Street at the joint
front corner of Lot Nos. 45 and 46 and running thence with the line of
Lot No. 46, S. 64-15 E. 149.6 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of
a 15-foot alley at the joint rear corner of Lot Nos. 45 and 46; thence with
the Western side of said 15-foot alley, S. 25-46 W. 80.4 feet to an iron pin
at the joint rear corner of Lot Nos. 44 and 45; thence with the line of
Lot No. 44, N. 64-15 W. 149.8 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of
Allen Street at the joint front corner of Lot Nos. 44 and 45; thence with
the Eastern side of Allen Street, N. 25-52 E. 80.4 feet to the point of
beginning.

recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina,
