ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, in the Rocky Creek Community, on the West side of State Highway 14 and having, according to a Plat entitled "Property of Gerald L. and Linda Smith" prepared by H. S. Brockman, R.L.S., Greer, South Carolina, February 26, 1968, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book XXX, Page 47, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
