

Greenville County, S.C., and having, according to a survey made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, September, 1960, revised May, 1961, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest edge of U. S. Highway No. 276, at northeast corner of property known as Pleasantdale Subdivision, and running thence along the line of property of Pleasantdale Subdivision, S. 80-57 W. 840 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 22-33 W. 161.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 87-47 E. 303.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-12 E. 310.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 76-48 W. 123.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 13-57 E. 148.3 feet to an iron pin on the southwest edge of U. S. Highway No. 276; thence along said highway, S. 60-01 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said highway, S. 53-48 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said highway, S. 47-03 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence still along said highway, S. 40-54 E. 130 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said highway, S. 36-18 E. 118.1 feet to the beginning corner.

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TRACT NO. 7 All that parcel or tract of land, located on the northeast side of an old public road and on the west side of Grove Creek, in Oaklawn Township, about two miles east of Pelzer, in Greenville County, S.C., and having, according to a survey made by W. M. Fennell, October 18, 1943, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Grove Creek and in the center of the old public road, and running thence along said road, N. 64 W. 5.17 chains to a point in road; thence continuing along said road, N. 65 W. 20.33 chains; thence N. 58 W. 2.00 chains; thence N. 78 W. 2.27 chains to a stone; thence N. 28 W. 14.70 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 28 E. 4.40 chains to a red oak; thence S. 74 E. 10.62 chains to a stone; thence N. 81 E. 20.40 chains to a stone, thence N. 25 E. 3.00 chains to a point in center of Grove Creek; thence along the center of Grove Creek in a southerly direction 46.40 chains, more or less, to the beginning corner, and containing, according to said plat referred to above, 65.59 acres.

ALSO that parcel of land situate in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, S.C., containing 1.5 acres and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING in the center of Pelzer-Woodside old road, joint corner of Otto Shirley and H. Greely Stanton property, thence in a southwesterly direction to edge of Farm Road and around Farm
