BENTLEY, hereafter referred to as Grantee, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grantees, their Heirs and Assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Gordon Street, being a part of Lot 35, as shown on plat of Earle Subdivision made by R. E. Dalton, May, 1922, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F", at Page 77, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of Gordon Street 444.5 feet west from the intersection of Gordon Street and White Horse Road, and at the corner of the property formerly owned by C. M. McDonald and running thence with the line of McDonald lot, S. 10-15 E. 200 feet to a stake in line of Lot 34; thence with line of Lot 34, S. 79-45 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot now or formerly owned by Polly Bridwell; thence with line of said lot, N. 10-25 W. 200 feet to a stake on Gordon Street; thence with the southern side of Gordon Street, N. 79-45 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner.
