the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto SIDNEY L. MAJOR & SUE D. MAJOR, Their Heirs and Assigns, Forever:

ALL that certain lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, Gowansville School District, containing 5 acres as shown on plat of Edward Alverson property by J. Q. Bruce, Surveyor, May 4, 1952, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING on old iron pin in old Landrum abandoned road, corner of lot of land bought from Paul and Sallie Reid, and running thence with their line S. 87-10 W. 131 feet to old iron pin; thence N. 87-45 W. 103 feet to old stone; thence S. 87-30 W. 457 feet to old iron pin on Petty line; thence with Petty line N. 4-30 E. 342 feet to stake and witness; thence a new line N. 88 E. 567 feet to point in present hard surfaced old Landrum road (for reference, small oak marked at S. 88 W. 17½ feet; thence with road S. 1-11 W. 38 feet; thence with said road S. 15 E. 297 feet; S. 2-11 W. 55 feet, last call along old abandoned road) to the point of beginning, this being part of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 of the T. H. Reid Subdivision.
