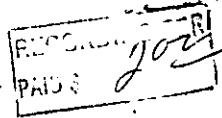

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AGREEMENT REGARDING PROPERTY
LINE

HERETOFORE a dispute has existed between Roy Pridmore and the heirs of J. J. Dill, deceased, who are Mrs. J. J. Dill, Mrs. Rosa Collins, Mrs. Pearl Mayfield, Mrs. Ida Langley, Mrs. Annie Mae White, Mrs. Myrtle Walls, and Mrs. Jessie Lee Burgess, regarding the boundary of the property between them. Subsequently Roy Pridmore deed his property to Jack Burrell and Joanne Burrell by deed dated November 16, 1972 and which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 960, at page 451. The parties have employed H. S. Brockman, RLS, to determine the common line. H. S. Brockman has made such determination and the parties have agreed to said line.

NOW THEREFORE, know all men by these presents, that the undersigned do hereby agree and stipulate the proper boundary between their two tracts is that shown on a plat entitled "Sketch showing the agreed line between Roy Pridmore and the Heirs of J. J. Dill, Deceased" made by H. S. Brockman, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book _____, at page _____.

As shown on said plat this agreed line is as follows: Beginning at a pin at the spring and running thence N. 64-00 E. 11 feet to a four inch iron pipe in old stump hole; thence N. 16-30 E. 178 feet to a large white oak; thence N. 11-30 E. 20.5 feet to a stake at a spring branch.

The parties each agree that they, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are bound by this agreement as to their disputed line.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties have hereunto set their hands and seals this 30 day of November, 1972.
