the same unto Charles Turner,

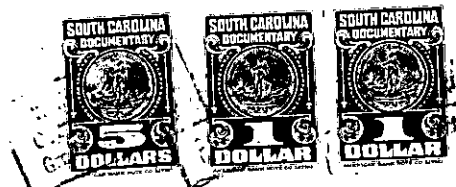
