ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land, together with all buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the western side of the Walker Road (running between Pine Log Ford Road and the Jackson Grove Road) in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as 5 acres on a plat of the property of Homer Styles made by Terry T. Dill, dated January 9, 1948, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book FF, page 516, and being a portion of Tract No. 7 of the J. T. 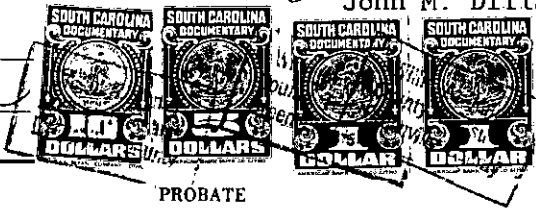
