(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Arnold Campbell and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Highland Township, on the south side of the Camp Creek Road near the old Lenoah School site, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of said road, corner of this lot and the Odom land, and running thence along the Odom line, S. 35-15 W. 300 feet to an iron pin in an old abandoned road; thence along said abandoned road S. 34-45 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence a new line in a northeasterly direction approximately 340 feet to the south side of the Camp Creek Road; thence along said road, N. 58-50 W. 116 feet to the beginning corner.
