TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said GREENVILLE COUNTY SEWER AUTHORITY, A BODY POLITIC, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER.

And the said Grantor does hereby bind itself and its successors and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Grantee hereinabove named, and its successors and assigns, against itself and its successors.

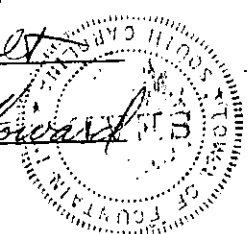
