KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, W. H. Alford

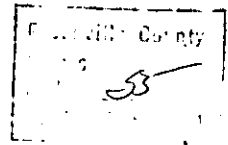
in consideration of -----Three Hundred and No/100 (\$300.00)----- Dollars,
