Thompson and Morris Weisz, d/b/a Clemson Terrace, a partnership, the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, hereby grants unto Max D. Thompson and Morris Weisz a right of way or easement along over or under our property for the purpose of installing and maintaining a sanitary sewer line, said right of way to extend along the northern side of the property of the Grantors herein, said property is known and designated as Lot 9, Block H of Woodville Heights Subdivision and known on the maps of the Block Book Department of Greenville County, South Carolina on Sheet 128-Block 3-Lot 19. Said right of way will be used for the purpose of tapping onto and using the Parker District Sewer Line. Said Grantees agree to be responsible for the maintenance of the right of way, and to put said sewer line deep enough to allow the Grantors to do certain plowing on their property.

Further, said Grantees agree to save harmless the Grantors from any damage that may occur as a result of their negligence with respect to said sewer right of way.

Together with the right to ingress and egress for the purpose of inspecting and maintaining the same.

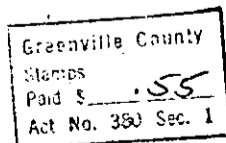
