

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, the said Master, in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars,

to me paid by the said Secretary of Housing and Urban Development of Washington, D. C., his successors and assigns,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Secretary of Housing and Urban Development of Washington, D. C., his successors and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the eastern side of Glendale Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 22 and part of Lot No. 21, as shown on a Plat of Glendale Heights, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "KK", at page 143, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Glendale Street, at the joint front corner of Lots 22 and 23, and running thence with the common line of said lots N. 83-15 E. 130 feet to an iron pin; thence running S. 6-45 E. 87.5 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 21; thence with a new line through Lot 21 S. 83-15 W. 130 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Glendale Street; thence with the line of said Street N. 6-45 W. 87.5 feet to the point of beginning.
