All our right, title and interest in and to:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the Western side of Urban Street (formerly Palmetto Street) being known and designated as the rear portions of Lots Nos. 52, 53 and 54 as shown on plat entitled "Property of West End Land & Improvement Company", recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book A at page 153 on April 11, 1907, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 34, 35 and 55 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 55 N. 79 E. 52 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 55; thence with a new line through Lots Nos. 52, 53 and 54 S. 11 E. 120 feet to an iron pin in a new line through Lot No. 52; thence with the new line through Lot No. 52 S. 79 W. 52 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 32; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 32, 33 and 34 N. 11 W. 120 feet to the point of beginning.
