LANDEL PROPERTIES, a partnership, its heirs and assigns, forever:
All of my right, title and interest in and to the following property:

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, City of Greenville, lying at the eastern intersection of North Street and Williams Street and being the northern portion of Lot No. 1 of Block 7 as shown on a plat of Boyce Addition dated January 13, 1904, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 90, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake at the eastern corner of North Street and Williams Street and running thence with the southern side of North Street, N. 76-45 E. 100 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 2 as shown on said plat; thence with the common line of Lots 1 and 2 as shown on said plat, S. 15 E. 130 feet to a stake at the corner of property now or formerly of Arthur McC. Griffin; thence with the line of property now or formerly belonging to Griffin, S. 76-45 W. 100 feet to a stake on the eastern side of Williams Street; thence with the eastern side of Williams Street, N. 15 W. 130 feet to a stake, the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to Mordecai Nachman and W. S. Judy by deed from C. M. Wing recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 306, page 423, less, however, part thereof taken for condemnation by the South Carolina Highway Department. The said W. S. Judy died testate on May 18, 1961, as shown by reference to his estate file recorded in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment No. 736, File 10. His one-half interest in the above described property was devised to his wife, Daisy S. Judy, and to his children, Daisy Jane Judy, Murray S. Judy, William S. Judy, Jr., and Edward P. Judy. The said Edward P. Judy died intestate being a resident of North Carolina, and his interest in the above described property was acquired by William S.
