Boyd Greene, his heirs and assigns forever:

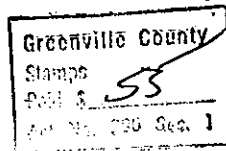
ALL MY RIGHT, TITLE, INTEREST IN AND TO:
