

PARCEL No. 2: On the Reservoir Road, containing 68/100 of an acre, more or less, according to a survey and plat made by W. J. Riddle, November 19, 1936, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in branch on line of Lot No. 5 of the Amanda Young property, and running thence S. 87-15 E. crossing Reservoir Road 196 feet to a stake; thence N. 29-33 E. 224 feet to a stake; thence N. 28-45 W. 55 feet to a stake in branch; thence with branch S. 50-30 W. 367 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, and being the remainder of the property conveyed to me by the Orr deed above mentioned.

PARCEL No. 3: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of the Paris Mountain State Park Road, which stake is the Southwestern corner of Grantor's property, and running thence with his line N. 89 E. 116 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 31-14 W. 58.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 89 W. 92 feet to a stake on said road; thence with said road N. 7 - 11 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same property that was conveyed to me by Mignon Woodward Hoffman Kelley, dated October 22, 1955, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office aforesaid in Deed Book 537 at page 294.
