Said premises being the same conveyed by deed recorded in Deed Book 273 at page 324.

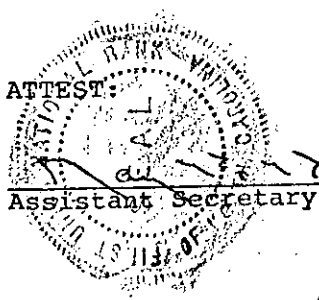
