INVOLUNTARY TERMINATION

12. In the event that Tenant shall become permanently disabled, involuntarily inducted into military service, or die, then and in either event, Tenant or his heirs, executors or administrators, as the case may be, shall have the option to terminate and cancel this Lease Agreement, upon thirt (30) days written notice to the Landlord, but such termination shall not release or discharge any payment of rent due and payable hereunder and then accrued, or any liability then accrued by reason of any agreement or covenant herein contained on the part of the Tenant.
