JOSEPH CLYDE WOOD, JR. AND LATRELL M. WOOD, their heirs and assigns forever:

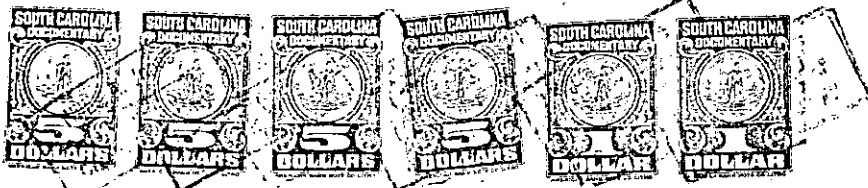

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Holtzclaw Road, joint front corners of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 and running thence along the line of said Lots, N. 26-24 E. 225 feet to iron pin, rear line of Lot 21; thence running with rear line of Lots 21 and 20, N. 63-36 W., 100 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot 8; thence running with line of said lot, S. 26-24 W., 225 feet to iron pin on Holtzclaw Road; thence running with Holtzclaw Road, S. 63-36 E., 100 feet to iron pin, point of beginning. -265-T35.1-1-7

Said property to be used for residential purposes only, except that Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 47, 48, 49, 50 and 51 may be used for business or church purposes; no residence to cost less than \$7,500.00; no building to be erected nearer than 30 feet from the street on which it faces; no lot to be subdivided; this conveyance is subject to all easements and rights-of-way of record.

This conveyance is made subject to any restrictive covenants, building set-back lines, rights-of-way and easements which may affect the above described property.
