aforesaid purposes.

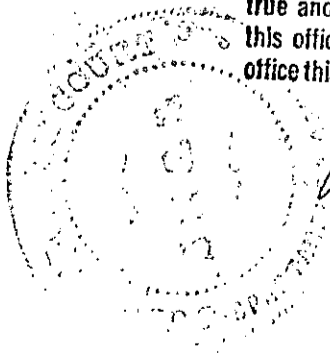
