THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 22nd day of September, 1973, by and between EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF GREENVILLE COUNCIL NO. 444 OF THE UNITED COMMERCIAL TRAVELERS, hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), and J. E. SIRRINE COMPANY, a South Carolina corporation, hereinafter called "Grantee";

W I T N E S S E T H :

That Grantor, in consideration of One and No/100ths (\$1.00) Dollar and the premises, paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, subject to the limitations hereinafter described, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use a storm sewer line, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tract of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Being a strip of land twenty-five (25) feet wide extending twelve and one-half (12 1/2) feet on each side of the center line during construction and thereafter being ten (10) feet wide extending five (5) feet on each side of the center line and being Two Hundred Sixty (260) feet, more or less, in length.

The land of the Grantor over which said rights and easements are granted is a part of the property described in the deed from Mary Frances McConnell Plowden, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 503 at page 499.
