ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the easterly side of St. Marks Road, the aforesaid tract being known as the homeplace and containing three acres, more or less, and being the identical property heretofore conveyed to our mother, Lula H. Owens, by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 161, at Page 292, and being all of Lot No. 6 of plat by H. S. Brockman, February, 1931, of the Jacob Hodge Estate, and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center line of above mentioned road at corner of Lot No. 5; thence with Lot 5, S. 63-40 E. 176.2 feet to iron pin on Jacob Hodge, Jr. line, corner of Lot No. 5; thence with said Hodge property, S. 68-07 E. 286.6 feet to iron pin on W. H. McCauley line and Jacob Hodge, Jr. corner; thence with McCauley N. 24-53 W., 418 to iron pin in center line of road; thence with road, S. 26-20 W., 523.2 feet to the point of Beginning.

Lula H. Owens died intestate in said County and State on June 8, 1959, leaving surviving her, her husband, Sam Owens, and five children: Maggie O. Featherstone, Inez O. Smith, Laeunice O. Johnson, Minnie O. Lyons and Orelious Owens; that Sam Owens died testate in said County and State on January 4, 1964, leaving of force his Last Will and Testament which is of file in the Probate Court in Apartment 853, File 8, and by his Will devised his interest in the "homeplace", the above described property, to his daughter, Maggie O. Featherstone.
