WHEREAS, Stephen L. Whitten, 108 Glen Rd., Greenville, S. C.
Richard A. Maxwell, 3 Charcross Court, Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

DEL NORTE COMMUNITY CLUB, INC.

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 27th day of

August, A. D. 19 73, file with Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in the

County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

And WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is DEL NORTE COMMUNITY CLUB, INC.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is 108 Great Glen Rd. Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to inspire, promote and sponsor cultural and civic improvements and activities that will enhance the general well-being of the membership and community at large.

FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:
