

during construction but after construction shall be reduced to 25 feet wide. It was determined that a twenty-five (25) feet right of way would be all that was necessary for maintenance and repair of the lines after their installation. After full and complete discussion of the matter and the taking of testimony, and after due consideration:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Greenville County Sewer Authority, that the value of the right-of-way being taken, together with any special damage occasioned by the construction of the sewer line is, in accordance with the applicable constitutional and statutory provisions, found to be One Dollar (\$1.00) per foot.
