hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said Grantee(s), the following described property situated in the county of

Greenville South Carolina, to wit:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and
improvements thereon, lying and being on the northerly side of Neal Circle,
near the City of Greenville, S. C., being known and designated as Lot No. 5
on plat of North Acres Subdivision as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book EE, pages 12-13; said lot having a
frontage of 80 feet on the northerly side of Neal Circle, a depth of 100 feet
on the easterly side, a depth of 100 feet on the westerly side, and 80 feet
across the rear; being the same property conveyed to Donald Carl Shank and
Catherine Smith Shank by deed recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book
