(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, seld, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jerry D.Mulligan , his heirs and assigns:

Those two certain lots of land in or near the Town of Greer, Chicks Springs Township, Greenville County South Carolina, designated as Lots Nos. 21 & 20 on plat of the M.T. Gaines property by W.A. Christopher, June 14,1923, retraced by H.S. Brockman May 19,1936 and togather bounded North by lots No. 6 & 7; Easte by Lot No. 19; South by Cannon Avenue; and West by Lot No. 22, and separately having the following courses and distances;
Lot No. 21 beginning at a point-corner of lot No. 22 on northern edge of Cannon Avenue, and running thence with Cannon Avenue S 82-15 E 60
