

Edwards Lake property, on the East and South by land now or formerly of Grace C. Golightly, et al, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:



BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of access road, and running thence N. 20=00 W., 316 feet to an iron pin on W. W. Edwards line; thence N. 37-23 E., 107.8 feet to an iron pin on Edwards line; thence S. 20-00 E., 373.5 feet to an iron pin in field; thence S. 70-00 W., 90.8 feet to the beginning corner.
