in consideration of Three Thousand ----- (\$3,000.00) ----- Dollars,

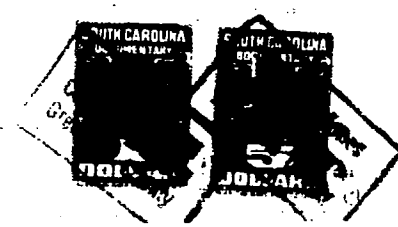
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
