BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Greenville County Sewer Authority, that the value of the right of way being taken, together with any special damage occasioned by the construction of the sewer line is, in accordance with the applicable constitutional and statutory provisions, found to be One and No/100 Dollar per foot.

Check of the Authority to be determined at \$ 1.00 per foot payable to the property owners is to be filed with the Clerk at the time of the filing of this Resolution with authority duly given to the Clerk to deliver such check to the landowner.
