



AMENDMENT TO RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

WHEREAS, by Right of Way Agreement executed by B. S. Neely dated June 28, 1949, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office in and for said County, in Book 388, Page 125 (hereinafter referred to as Original Agreement), TRANSCONTINENTAL GAS PIPE LINE (hereinafter called Transcontinental), is the owner of a right of way and easement for pipe line purposes across the lands described therein situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, reference being here made to said Original Agreement and its record for a complete description of the lands involved and all other purposes; and

WHEREAS, Transcontinental has heretofore constructed four pipe lines across said lands in accordance with said Original Agreement and may in the future, from time to time, desire to construct additional pipe lines pursuant thereto, and Wilton T. Cook and Hester D. Cook, his wife (hereinafter called Grantor), as the present owner of said lands by Deed from the estate of B. S. Neely, dated September 4, 1973, recorded in said Office in Book 983, Page 295, have requested Transcontinental to enter into this agreement for the purpose of defining Transcontinental's right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between Transcontinental and Grantor that said Original Agreement shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

1. Transcontinental's right of way shall be limited to a strip of land 152 feet in width being all of the lands between a line drawn 15 feet southeasterly of, adjacent and parallel to the most southeasterly of Transcontinental's four presently existing pipe lines, and a line drawn 137 feet northwesterly of and parallel to said pipe line.

During the original construction of additional pipe lines, maintenance and replacement of pipe lines, Transcontinental shall have the right to clear and use, as temporary work space only, reasonable areas adjoining said permanent right of way.

2. Grantor shall make no use of said right of way which would affect or endanger Transcontinental's pipe lines or interfere with the construction of additional pipe lines.

For and in consideration of the premises, Grantor does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto Transcontinental, its successors and assigns, a right of way and easement in accordance with the terms and provisions of said

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
