I, Robert E. Smith, hereafter referred to as Grantor, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and love and affection... DOLLARS, paid to Grantor by Lenord Ray Smith hereafter referred to as Grantee, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grantee, Lenord Ray Smith, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Tract No. 1 on plat of property of "Leonard Ray Smith," prepared by T. H. Walker, Jr., Reg. L. S., dated November 24, 1973, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5E at Page 82, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an old iron pin at the joint front corner of Lot 23 and Tract No. 1 on Ridgewood Drive, and running thence along Ridgewood Drive, N. 59-07 E., 210 feet to a point, joint corner of Tract No. 1 and Tract No. 2; thence turning and running along line of Tract No. 2, N. 2-06 W., 236.67 feet to a point; thence turning and running S. 59-07 W., 210 feet to a point in the joint line of Lot 23 and Tract No. 1; thence turning and running S. 2-06 E., 236.67 feet to the beginning corner on Ridgewood Drive, and containing 1.0 acre, more or less.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to grantor herein by S. A. Cureton by deed dated February 21, 1947, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 307 at Page 428.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the Grantee and Grantee's Heirs/Successors and Assigns forever. AND Grantor does hereby bind Grantor and Grantor's Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto Grantee and Grantee's Heirs/Successors and Assigns against Grantor and Grantor's Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
