TOGETHER with that certain easement appurtenant for lateral foundation support, the same covering a strip of land with a width of 5 feet, more or less, and a length of 199.28 feet as shown on plat entitled "Site Plan", prepared by H. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4-Z at page 67; said easement appurtenant being created and evidenced by agreements entitled "Agreement" and "Easement for Lateral Foundation Support", each executed by The City of Greenville, South Carolina, in favor of The South Carolina National Bank and each dated February 27, 1973, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Books 970 at page 581 and 970 at page 583, respectively.
