POWER OF ATTORNEY

1. To exercise or perform any act, power, duty, right, or obligation whatsoever that I now have, or may hereafter acquire the legal right, power, or capacity to exercise or perform, in connection with, arising from, or relating to any person, item, transaction, claim, business property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, or matter whatsoever;

2. To conduct, engage in, and transact any and all lawful business of whatever nature or kind for me, on my behalf, and in my name;

3. To request, ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect, receive, withdraw, and hold and possess all such sums of money, commercial paper, checks, drafts, accounts, deposits and proceeds, which I may be legally entitled to;

4. To sign my name on all checks, including checks from the Social Security Administration, and to withdraw and deposit money from and to all banking and savings accounts which I now have;

5. This instrument is to be construed and interpreted as a general power of attorney. The enumeration of specific items, rights, acts, or powers herein is not intended to, nor does it, limit or restrict, and is not to be construed or interpreted as limiting or restricting, the general powers herein granted to said Attorney-in-Fact. This power of attorney shall end on March 1, 1975.
