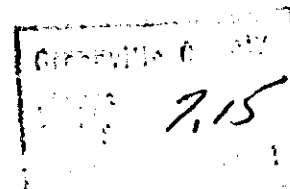
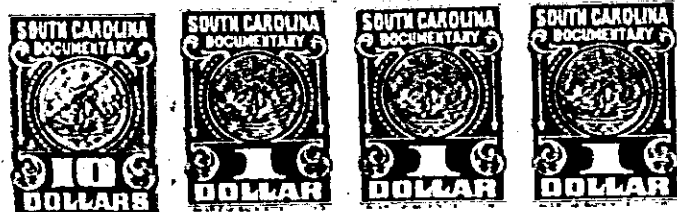

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Saluda Township, containing 2.3 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of a tract now or formerly of Evertie E. Reeves, et al. and running thence along the line of that tract, N. 43 E. 7.57 chains to a point in Glorsia Road; thence along said road, N. 29 1/2 W. 1.25 chains to a point; thence continuing along said road, N. 45 W. 1.95 chains to point in said road at corner of property now or formerly of E.
