That, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantors have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, grant and convey unto the Grantees, their heirs and assigns, a temporary right of way or easement, including the right to enter upon the real estate hereinafter described, at any time that the Grantees might see fit, during the life of this easement or right of way, to construct, maintain, and repair an underground septic tank drainfield for the purpose of serving a septic tank located on the property of the Grantees, and also for the construction of a well, together with the right to excavate and refill ditches for the allocation of said drainfield and well, and the further right to remove trees, bushes, undergrowth and other obstructions interfering with the location, construction and maintenance of said drainfield and well.

The easement or right of way shall be effective until sewer is provided to the area at which time the Grantees shall be required to tap on to the public sewer and this easement or right of way shall be terminated at that time.

The land affected by the grant of this easement and right of way is located in Greenville County, South Carolina and is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the northeasterly side of Shady Grove Church Road at the northerly corner of Holly Springs Lodge

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
