And the undersigned does hereby bind itself, its successors, and the heirs of Laura Peace Echols, to warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said ALEXANDER M. PATRICK and CLAYTON L. PATRICK, their heirs and assigns forever, against it and its successors, and the heirs of Laura Peace Echols, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
