This being the identical property conveyed to R. G. Gilreath by deed of Mattie A. Roark, recorded in Greenville County Deed Book 181 at Page 387, on September 7, 1935. R. G. Gilreath later died testate on February 17, 1943, and by the terms of his Will, devised the subject real estate to his wife, Lee Bolt Gilreath, reference being made to Greenville County Probate File designated Apartment 460 at File 3. Thereafter, Lee Bolt Gilreath died testate on March 17, 1973, and by the terms of her Will, appointed John Robert Waters her Executor, with power to convey real estate, reference being made to Greenville County Probate File designated Apartment 1276 at File 3. This conveyance is pursuant to those powers conferred upon John Robert Waters by the terms of the Will of Lee Bolt Gilreath in his capacity as Executor of that Estate.
