the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Ethel Howard, her heirs and assigns forever,

All those parcels or lots of land in Oneal Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, located about 2.5 miles north of the City of Greer, near the Mosteller Mill, lying on the east side of Holliday Road, and being shown as Lots Nos. 28 and 29 on a plat of the property made for the Agnes M. Holliday Estate by John A. Simmons, Registered Surveyor, dated May 4, 1966, designated as HOLLIDAY HILL, SECTION 2, which plat is recorded in Plat Book PPP, page 5, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. Reference to said plat and record thereof is expressly made for a complete and detailed description of said lots.
