Pursuant to a notice duly given, a meeting of the Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority was held in the offices of Hill, James & Wyatt, Attorneys at Law, 100 Williams Street, Greenville, South Carolina, at 10:00 A.M., August 15, 1974 for the purpose of determining just compensation and damages, if any, to be paid to Elinor Smith Rodgers for the condemnation of a right of way across property described in the Greenville County Block Book records as being Lot 30, Sheet 530.5, Block 1, acquired by Elinor Smith Rodgers by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 625 at Page 309.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority that the value of the right of way being taken together with any special damage occasioned by the construction of the sewer line is in accordance with the applicable constitutional and statutory provisions, found to be One Dollar (\$1.00) per foot.

Let notice of this Resolution be promptly given to Elinor Smith Rodgers and let a notice of this Resolution be promptly filed in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina. Check of the District to be determined at \$1.00 per foot payable to the property owner is to be filed with the Clerk of Court at the time of the filing of this Resolution with authority duly given to the Clerk to deliver such check to the landowner.

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
