

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that WE, WADE PIERCE and RUBY T. PIERCE

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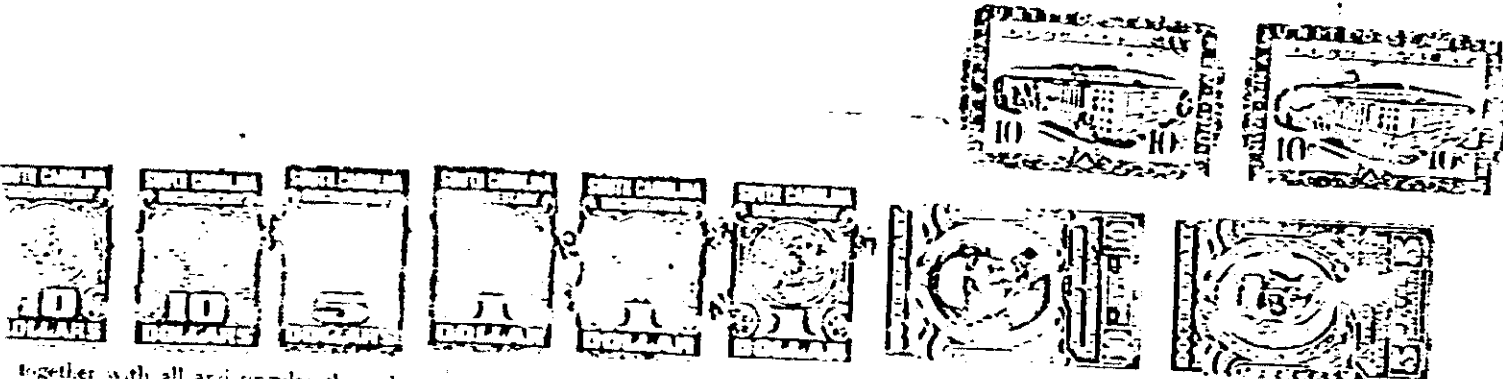


In consideration of TEN DOLLARS AND OTHER CONSIDERATION... Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto JAMES R. WHITTED, HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER

ALL of that tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina in Bates Township, near the Greenville County and Pickens County line and being a portion of the C. L. Eppes Estate and containing 7 acres, more or less, and having, by calculation, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the Pickens-Marietta Road at the corner of property of Buck C. Adams and running thence along the center of said road in a northerly direction 700 feet, more or less, to the corner of A.R. and Millie Taber; thence N 78 W 231 feet to an iron pin; thence N 16 E 376.14 feet to an iron pin; thence along property of Robert and Marguerita Whitted, S 78 E 231 feet to a point in the center of said Road; thence along the center of said road, 1170.18 feet, more or less, to the corner of property of J.H. Bates; thence N 79 W 389.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N 11-30 W 445.0 feet to an iron pin; thence N 79 W 1689.6 feet to a point in the center of South Saluda River; thence along the said river in a southerly and then southwesterly direction 3060.42 feet; thence S 47 E 421.03 feet to an iron pin; thence along the property of Clyde Teaster N 88 E 351.12 feet to an iron pin; thence N 63 E 564.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N 62 E 628.98 feet to an iron pin; thence S 43 E 1320 feet to the point of beginning.

The above description is an approximation, without survey, of the remaining land, after conveyances, inherited by Bettie Ida Eppes from C. L. Eppes in Apt. 408, file 18, and conveyed to him in Deed Book 166, page 375 by M.E. Eppes, who acquired the same in Apt. 201, file 59 from Isaac S.
