the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto GEORGE JONES and DIANA B. JONES, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southwestern side of Andover Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 77, as shown on a plat of Heritage Hills, made by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, May 26, 1964, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "YY", at Page 187 and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
