In consideration of Four Hundred Eighty-five and 71/100 (\$485.71)-----Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA

All my right, title, and interest in and to:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the southern side of Broad Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina having, according to a survey by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Broad Street at the corner of property formerly belonging to C. D. Speegle and running thence along the line of said Speegle Property S. 31-56 W. 102 feet to an iron pin near a branch; thence along property now or formerly belonging to W. C. Cleveland S. 68-33 E. 64.5 feet to an iron pin on the line of property to be conveyed to the City of Greenville; thence along said line N. 12-22 E. 61.7 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Broad Street; thence along the southern side of Broad Street N. 19-48 W. 55.2 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning, said lot containing approximately .19 acres more or less.

The above described property was conveyed to C. D. Speegle on February 26, 1925, a copy of said deed being recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 105 at Page 218. C. D. Speegle died testate on November 20, 1930 as shown by Probate file recorded in Apartment 301, File 3. Said testate devised the above described property to his wife, Ida R. Speegle, for life with vested remainder interest in his seven children. Ida R. Speegle died April 8, 1942 survived by all seven of the aforementioned children. One of said children, C. Daniel Speegle, died testate February 10, 1951, devising his one-seventh (1/7) interest in said property to his wife, Dorothy Lee Speegle (now NeSmith). The above named grantor is the sole devisee of C. Daniel Speegle, a deceased child of C. D. Speegle.
