KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that JAMES W. MAHON

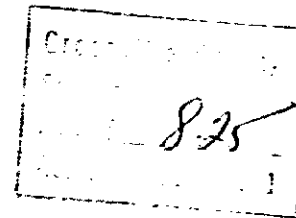
in consideration of SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100THS (\$7,500.00) Dollars,
