And I do further ratify and confirm that all things so done by my said attorney-in-fact within the scope of the authority herein given as fully and to the same extent as if by me personally done and performed.

I further declare that this power of attorney shall remain in full force and effect until I shall have notified in writing the banks in which I have accounts or establish accounts in the future that the same is withdrawn and cancelled or until cancelled or revoked as provided by North Carolina General Statute 47-115.1 or the Statutes of the State of South Carolina.

In the event that Ernest Decatur Brockman of Camden, South Carolina, my attorney-in-fact appointed herein, becomes physically or mentally incapacitated to handle my affairs as set forth above, resigns or dies while serving as my attorney-in-fact then I appoint my brother, J. S. Brockman, Raleigh, North Carolina as substitute attorney-in-fact with all of the powers and duties as hereinabove set forth.

People dealing with my substitute attorney-in-fact may do so by having my said substitute attorney-in-fact exhibit a death certificate, a certificate of commitment to a mental institution, or a resignation signed by Ernest Decatur Brockman.
